

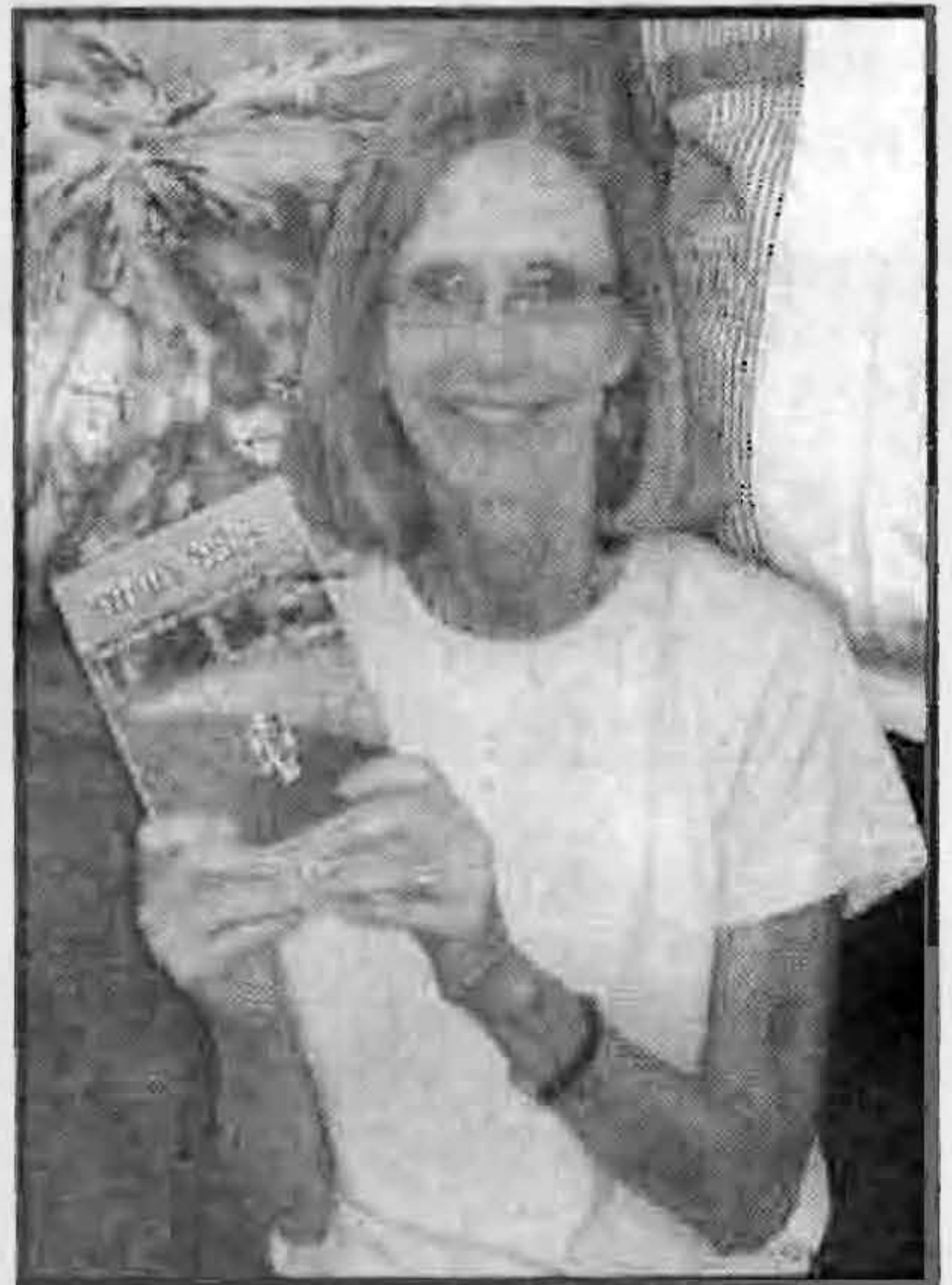
# Titan's Tales and Other Dog Adoption Love Stories to Hold Book Signing
